Our friends at Project Home, a local non-profit, volunteer organization, are reaching out to area faith groups to assist at a crucial juncture in their work with legal asylum seekers.



Project Home is seeking a safe, reasonably priced, 2-3 bedroom house or apartment for a family of 5 from Mexico. They have been hosted by a Keene family for close to a year and a half and are ready to move into an independent living situation.

This family has overcome great hardship in their journey so far and worked hard to establish a safe and productive life while awaiting an asylum hearing. They have been good neighbors and tenants. Their children have been thriving in their new school setting, learning English, and making friends. They are hoping to find a home in the SAU 29 school district so the children do not have to experience another uprooted transition.

Project Home will continue to provide legal and financial support for this family as they work to meet their goals of greater independence.

Please spread the word among your community in the hope that someone may know of a situation that could work for this family.

MIP Housing Team Update

As we reported in our last newsletter, following months of research and community dialogue, **MIP has chosen to prioritize advocacy directed at increased access to housing units and supportive services for people who earn under \$18 an hour for full time work.**

Recently, MIP has joined in with the [Monadnock Housing Roundtable](#) to collaborate with local housing leaders.

For the next phase of this work **MIP will be connecting with people directly impacted by housing inaccessibility and developing an educational powerpoint** to be shared in the Monadnock community with the intention of fostering understanding about housing insecurity and helping to facilitate more solutions to this long standing concern in our region.
