We invite you to join us at our next interfaith event, adiscussion of Dara Horn's *People Love Dead Jews*. Dara Horn's work has been selected by New York Times Notable Books, Booklist's Best 25 Books of the Decade, and San Francisco Chronicle's Best Books of the Year.

In *People Love Dead Jews*, she challenges us to confront the reasons why there might be so much fascination with Jewish deaths, as emblematic of the worst of evils the world has to offer, and little respect for Jewish lives, as they continue to unfold in the present.

MIP is one of numerous groups in the region reading Dara Horn's book.Our discussion will be co-lead by Rabbi Dan Aronson of Congregation Ahavas Achim and Reverend Becky Poor, Covenant Living's Interfaith Chaplain.
