1) Show up with MIP at the Keene City Council Budget Hearing, Thursday, June 6, 7pm in support of Keene's contribution to the Monadnock Housing Development Fund. Meet up at 6:50pm in City Hall first floor lobby, 3 Washington St. Meeting is on the second floor. Several MIP Housing Team members will be speaking in support!

#### 2) Visit the Housing display at the Keene Public Library, entitled: What do we imagine for future development in Keene?

MIP worked with the Keene State College architecture program sophomore class to envision a mixed residential and commercial district along the Gilbo Avenue corridor in Keene.

## **Prayer of St. Francis**


Sunday June 23, 1:30 - 4:00 pm Saint Francis Chapel Stone Pond, Marlborough, NH


Many thanks to everyone who helped with the planning, made a presentation, provided a game, staffed a table, brought food, and all those who came in fellowship and love.

#### June 12-13 – Shavuot

Celebrates the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai. Shavuot is the Hebrew word for "weeks," and the holiday occurs seven weeks after Passover. Like many other Jewish holidays, Shavuot began as an ancient agricultural festival that marked the end of the spring barley harvest and the beginning of the summer wheat harvest.

#### June 14-19 – The Hajj

One of the five pillars of Islam, each believer is called, at least once in their lives, to make the Hajj, the annual pilgrimage that starts and ends in the holy



city of Mecca located in today's Saudi Arabia. The journey recreates Muhammad's own path as the native son returned to his tribal home as the leader of a vibrant new religion.

#### June 17-20 – Eid-al-Adha

The Feast of Sacrifice, is a commemoration of Ibrahim's act of obedience and his willingness to follow God's command without question. Eid al-Adha is a big Muslim celebration. People dress in their finest garments, often having bought new clothes for the occasion, and meet with family and friends to celebrate together.

#### June 21 – Litha

This Pagan and Wiccan festival is also known as Midsummer, the Summer Solstice. For modern day pagans, Litha is a day of inner power and brightness. This pivotal day gifts us with the longest stretch of daylight in the Northern Hemisphere, a vibrant celebration of fire and the sun, our essential source of life.
